Show Rules

1. An open chicken and fowl show is open to anyone of any age who owns fowl and would like to participate in the fowl show at the county fair.
2. Rabbits and other fur animals are also welcome.
3. Entries will be received Monday, September 30, 2019, from 3:00 PM until 7:00 PM.
4. All fowl entered in the show must be NPIP blood tested prior to the fair. It can be done so at the State Fair Grounds on August 31st. The Orangeburg Clemson Extension Office(Jonathan Croft) can be contacted for exact times.
5. All animals are to remain in the barn until after 3:00 PM on Sunday, October 7, 2018 unless due to health reasons or the decision of the barn manager.
6. All animals must appear healthy. We reserve the right to remove any animal which appears unhealthy.
7. Your name and address may be placed on the cage after judging.
8. While we will do our best to keep your animals as safe as possible, we will not be liable for lost, stolen or injured animals.
9. All animals will be fed and cared for daily. You are welcome to come in and help out with the care of your animal(s) but, for the safety of the animals and barn visitors, we request that all animals stay in their cages at all times.
10. Pre-registration— Please pre-register your animals and fowls so that we can make sure we have a spot reserved for you.
11. Ribbons and premiums will be awarded.
